TEAM ROADS LESS TRAVELED FINISHES 8TH IN 2018 REBELLE RALLY *Second Straight Top-10 Finish in Rebelle Rally for Team RLT*

DENVER (October 24, 2018) – For the second straight year, Tiffany Walker and Rori Lewis of Team Roads Less Traveled placed inside the top 10 of the Rebelle Rally, finishing in eighth place overall with 1,128 total points among 35 competing teams in the 4x4 class.

The duo also finished inside the top 10 as rookies in 2017, claiming the seventh spot.

The first women's off-road navigation rally in the United States, the Rebelle Rally covers more than 2,000 kilometers across the Nevada and California desert, blending the love of driving with the ultimate challenge of precise navigation.

Testing participants' skills, the Rebelle is not a race for speed, but a unique and demanding event based on the elements of headings, hidden checkpoints, time, and distance using maps, compass, and a roadbook – no GPS or cell phones.

Walker, of Colorado Springs, Colorado, and navigator Lewis, of Hesperia, California, saw their strongest performances on Days 4 and 5, navigating every checkpoint each day.

"We woke up on Day 4 ready to rally after a tough first three days," noted Lewis. "I got sick on the rally's first day and Tiffany was sick on Day 2. But things definitely came together for us and we started having fun.

"Frustration could have taken us out of the competition after our rough start but I could not be more proud of how we continued to fight."

Day 3 saw the team suffer a punctured tire, resulting in just 13 successfully navigated checkpoints due to course time restrictions as checkpoints must be reached within the allotted times.

"Day 3 came with some incredibly challenging terrain," says Walker. "We got stuck in a wash with no obvious way out. I was concerned about time and started driving too fast for the conditions and drove over a sage bush.

"We realized we had a flat not long after – a roughly 3-inch gash in the tire's sidewall – and with the time it took to change the tire, we had to sacrifice quite a few checkpoints. But we bounced back and were able to press on with a solid performance."

Overall, Walker and Lewis navigated 107 of a possible 130 checkpoints over seven days of competition en route to their second straight top-10 finish at the Rebelle Rally.
